

Dominick, Jeanie, Conrad and I signed up for a Greek Island Cycling Cruise with Santana Adventures only to learn that Brent and Carol were on the waiting list. Well with a change in the dates, a few cabins opened up and Brent and Carol got on the trip too. The trip started and ended in Athens at a very scary time with the world crisis in the Middle East. Fortunately for us, our trip was unaffected by the war. Visiting ancient ruins only reminded us of the never ending atrocities that have gone on since humans began exploring and expanding their turf. Excavations of ruins always include weapons and evidence of land grabs for an opposing point of view. Proving once again that history repeats itself and my dad's favorite way of saying it, "Nothing has changed but the date on calendar." That said the trip was truly amazing.

































### Membership Corner By Steve Geary



### JBC Ride Definitions / Rules / Etiquette

SG - Show & Go - ride leaders, and distances can be decided at the ride

S - Social - Group stays together, rides at posted level, has ride leader.

Ride contacts are to be called for information about the ride.

All riders should plan to arrive at any scheduled ride at least 10 minutes before the scheduled departure time.

### AD HOC RIDES

- 1. A non-calendar ride, via google groups email invite
- 2. 12 hour advance notice, e.g. Friday 8am ride invite sent by 8pm Thursday
- 3. Invite must include starting time, location and ride level (I-V)
- 4. Additional details about the ride can be shared too.
- 5. Miles are recorded as: AH/date/leader initials/miles/riders (in alpha form).
- 6. Use AD Hoc number assigned to the day of the ride
- 7. 2 riders minimum for in-state and out of state rides
